Using our Institutional Repository (IR), *Digital Commons @ Olivet*, constituents from Olivet Nazarene University, including students, faculty, adjunct faculty, alumni, staff, and emeritus faculty can post archival and scholarly content online. Each posted item (a paper, poster, digitized magazine, or yearbook) has a metadata page which is indexed by search engines, allowing for discovery by anyone with a connection to the Internet. Olivet Nazarene University launched *Digital Commons* as part of Academic Vice President Gregg Chenoweth's *March Toward Meaning*, a period emphasizing scholarly work by faculty. In addition to the scholarly work of our faculty, our Digital repository has grown to include doctoral dissertations, student essays, honors student projects, schedules for Scholar Week and the 2016 Kankakee River Watershed conference, and more.

Our content truly reaches a global audience, as depicted in the screen shot below, which shows where readers are located. Areas in orange (United States, United Kingdom, Philippines) have the highest concentration of readers, followed by green, yellow, purple, and blue. This readership map was generated using data from April 5, 2010- June 30, 2018.



In addition to reader location, the dashboard in *Digital Commons* provides information about the organizational type. Since our founding in April 2010, readers from nearly 12,000 institutions have browsed *Digital Commons* content, with more than half from educational institutions. Commercial domains make up one-third of visitors, followed by organizations, government, and military.
