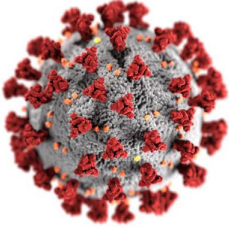

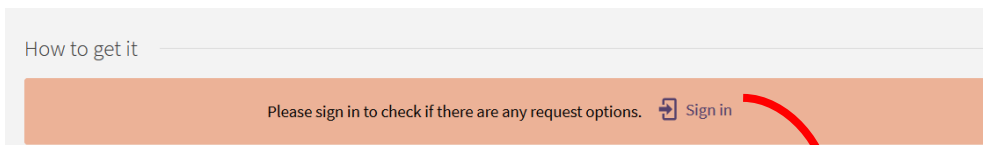
Covid Update:
I-Share delivery

“Olivet Nazarene University participates in a network of 90+ libraries in Illinois, called I-Share. Usually, the network has vehicles making daily deliveries around the State for patron-requested books, DVDs, and mor. However, due to covid shutdowns and restrictions, some partner libraries aren’t fully open. As of August 14th, our own library is only getting deliveries three times per week, instead of our usual five.

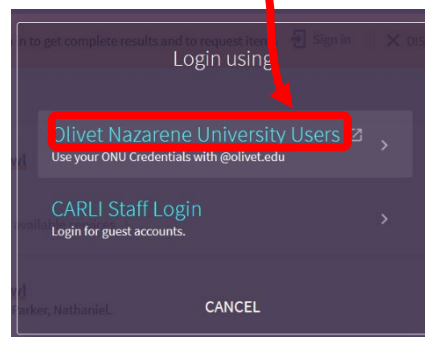
All of this means that you can request books using I-Share, but you need to allow for more time AND you need to keep checking the status of your request and your email in case the book is owned by a library that isn’t currently lending. Need help? Ask Interlibrary Loan (ILL@olivet.edu) staff to help you investigate, or to get the item from a different network.”

IF YOU NEED TO BORROW BOOKS FROM A PARTNER LIBRARY, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

2. Click on the “Books & Media” tab.
3. Requesting I-Share books
4. New authentication for I-share (book) borrowing (use your ONU username & password)
