

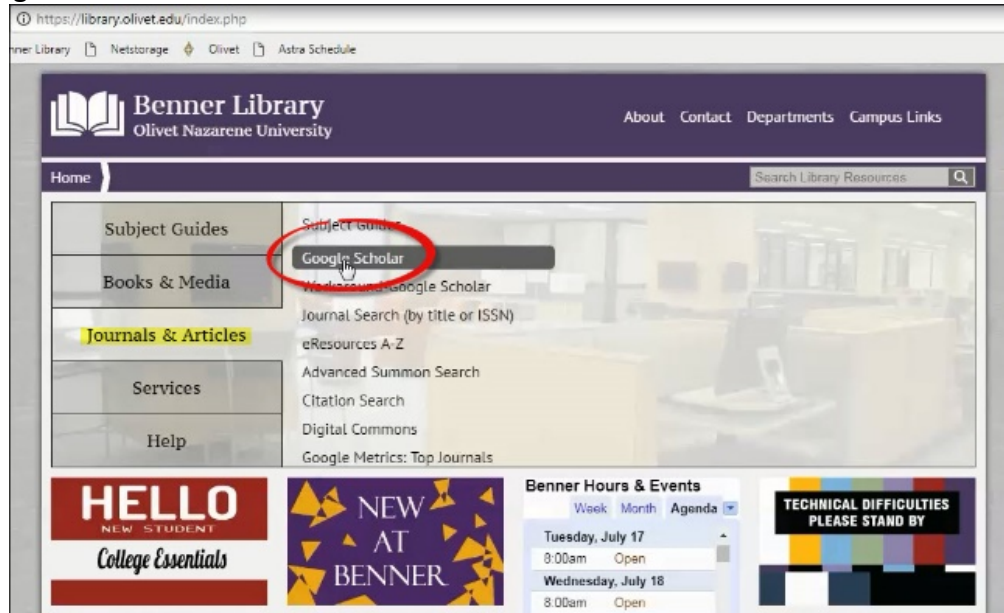
# Google Scholar

## Accessing Google Scholar

**Step 1:** Go to the library website using the web address library.olivet.edu

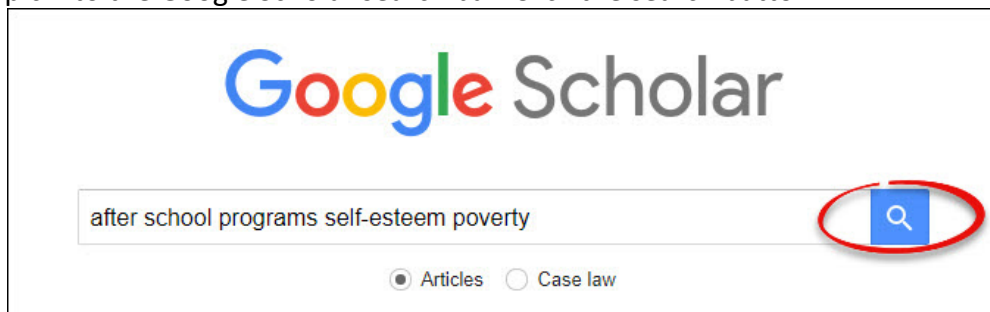
**Step 2:** Click the *Journals & Articles* tab.

**Step 3:** Click Google Scholar.

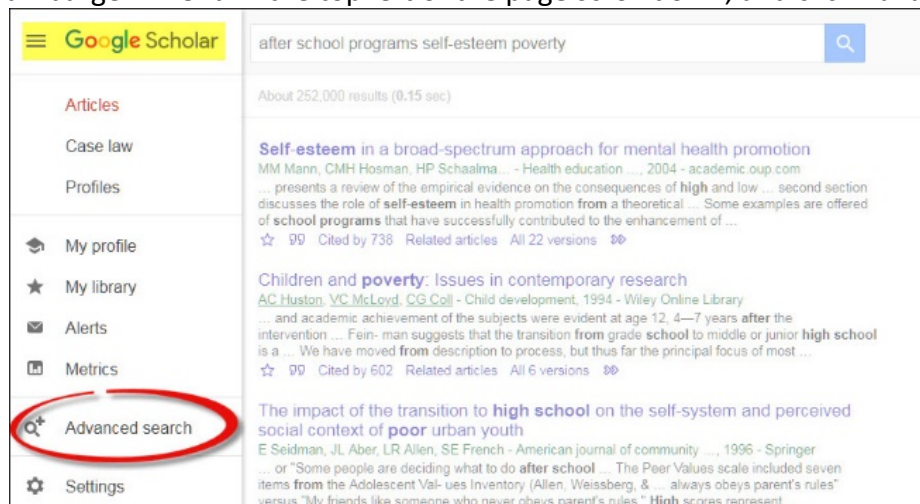


## Using Google Scholar

**Step 1:** Type a topic into the Google Scholar search bar. Click the search button.



**Step 2:** Click the “hamburger” menu in the top left of the page scroll down, and click *Advanced Search*.



**Step 3:** Add quotations around phrases in the search bar titled *with all the words* to create a Phrase Search.

**Step 4:** In the third search box titled *with at least one of the words*, add the words "research method study".

**Step 5:** Limit the date range using the box towards the bottom of the advanced search titled *return articles dated between*.

Step 1: Click the link on the right-hand side of any search result to get full text for a specific article.
