Subject Guide	Recommended databases
Biblical Literature Theology	<p><u><i>ATLA Religion Database</i></u> is the premier research database for your field.</p> <p><u><i>Christian Periodical Index</i></u> covers magazines & journals with an evangelical perspective.</p> <p><u><i>Jstor</i></u>: Before searching, scroll down to “Journal Filter” in order to limit by discipline.</p>
Christian Education Christian Ministry	<p>See suggestions for “Biblical Literature” & “Theology” above.</p> <p>Go to the “Education: Professional” subject guide for education research.</p> <p>Use <u><i>PsycARTICLES</i></u> for full text psychology articles regarding counseling & human development research. <u><i>PsycINFO</i></u> has more article citations, but not all are available in full text. Request articles through Interlibrary Loan if necessary.</p>
History Law Political Science	<p>Start with <u><i>Academic Search Complete</i></u>.</p> <p><u><i>Political Science database</i></u>: research & popular articles in political science & international relations.</p> <p><u><i>Global Issues in Context</i></u>: Controversial & contemporary issues. Results from popular, scholarly, & primary sources.</p> <p><u><i>Jstor</i></u>: Before searching, scroll down to “Journal Filter” in order to limit by discipline.</p> <p>Use “Look up a Legal Case” option in <u><i>Lexis-Nexis</i></u> to find Case Law. Make an appointment with Judson Strain, Reference Librarian, if you need to use this database extensively.</p>
Military Science	<p>Start with <u><i>Military & Government Collection</i></u></p> <p><u><i>Academic Search Complete</i></u> is broader</p>
Philosophy	<u><i>Philosophers Index</i></u>
